## **Music Scholarship**

This scholarship is awarded to a local high school senior who has shown outstanding achievement in music, has participated in school and community performances and plans to continue musical study as a major or in extra-curricular activities.

### **Qualifications:**

To be considered for the scholarship, an applicant must **submit all of the following:**

1. A completed OACC Senior Scholarship Application Form. The form is available at [www.oneidachorale.org](http://www.oneidachorale.org). or from the applicant's high school music teacher. The application should be submitted by email along with the recording and letter of recommendation. The completed application (on back of this form) must be signed by both the student and the student's parent or guardian.
2. A video recording (no more than 8 minutes) of an applicant's solo performance best representative of his or her outstanding achievements in music. The solo performance should be similar to a NYSSMA Level IV-VI solo on the applicant's main instrument. The applicant is required to record the performance showing their full body from knees up. Applicants are required to identify themselves, the high school they attend and what they will be performing at the beginning of the video.
3. A letter of recommendation from your music teacher that represents your solo recording. (For example, if you are singing, your choral teacher, wind instruments or percussion, your band teacher and string instruments, your orchestra teacher) The letter of recommendation should be emailed with the application and video.

### **Deadlines:**

The scan of the completed recommendation, video recording and letter of recommendation must be emailed to [mbunceoacc@gmail.com](mailto:mbunceoacc@gmail.com) by May 1<sup>st</sup>. Late or incomplete submissions will not be considered.
